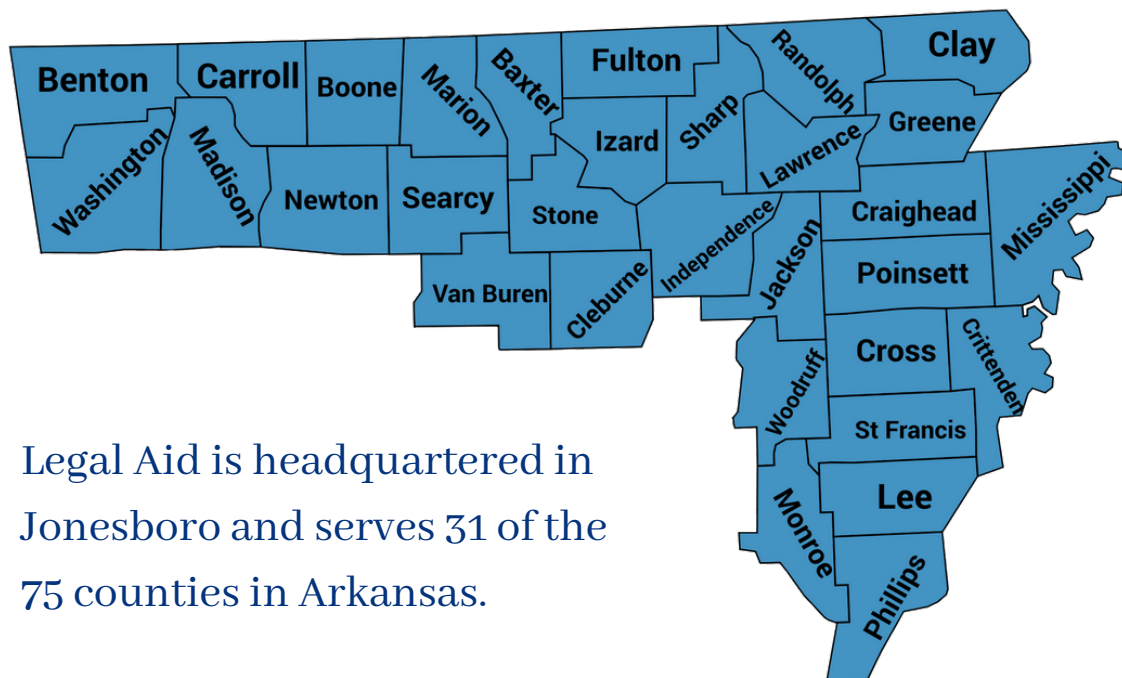
WHAT IS LEGAL AID?

Legal Aid is a nonprofit organization that provides free civil legal services to low-income individuals residing in the state of Arkansas.

WHO QUALIFIES FOR LEGAL AID?
