Job duties will include, but are not limited to:

- Representing clients in all levels of a case, including negotiations, trials, and appeals.
- Researching legal issues and providing legal advice.

- Drafting legal fact sheets and outreach materials.
- Integration into a Legal Aid workgroup.
- Conducting intakes and interviews for applicants seeking legal assistance.

- Arkansas bar admission or eligible for reciprocity.
- Medical technology/information privacy knowledge a plus.
- Ability to establish and maintain good community relationships.
- Ability to speak Spanish a plus.
- Driver's license and ability to travel throughout Arkansas.
