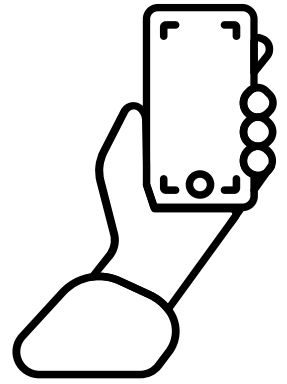

13. Pivot Rock and Natural Bridge
